Key Activities of the Month:

Oct. 2, 2022, Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed received Senator Jim Inhofe at his office where they held discussions.



Oct. 4, 2022, Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed inaugurated the newly built Science Museum located in the heart of Addis Ababa. Along with the official opening of the Science Museum, Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed also launched the technology startups and public/private institution exhibition, which was well-attended by the public over the next several weeks.



Oct. 6, 2022, Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed welcomed at Bole International Airport H.E. William Ruto, President of the Republic of Kenya. Later in the day, the two leaders held bilateral discussions along with their respective delegations.



Oct. 15, 2022, Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed presided over the opening ceremony of the 10th Tana Forum held in Bahir Dar. In his remarks, Prime Minister Abiy emphasized the actions that Africa should prioritize in order to overcome peace and security challenges and move toward resilience.



On the same day, Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed met with the President of the Sovereign Council of Sudan, Abdel Fattah Abdulrahman Al Burhan, for a bilateral discussion.



Oct. 16, 2022, Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed presided over a performance evaluation of main macroeconomic and Ministerial offices' first quarter plans.



Oct. 17, 2022, Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed and senior government officials visited the soybean cluster farm, which spans 38,000 hectares in the Central Gondar Zone and the 1,200-hectare soybean cluster farm in Addis Alem, Tegede woreda. Prime Minister Abiy stated that the encouraging results in wheat production will be replicated in other products.



On the same day, Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed and senior government leadership reviewed the progress of the Gorgora development project, which is part of the Dine for Ethiopia initiative.



Oct. 20, 2022, Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed inaugurated the Burayu Talent Development School. The school is built in such a way that students can improve their skills without interrupting their formal education. Along with the school, the project gave the surrounding community the opportunity to profit from infrastructure development.



Oct. 22, 2022, Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed, First Lady Zinash Tayachew, Deputy Prime Minister Demeke Mekonnen and senior government leadership have arrived in Jimma city where they inaugurated one of the schools built by the Office of the First Lady.



On the same day,

In Jimma City, Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed visited a 10-hectare intercropping farm. The farm includes fruit and vegetable production, fish farming, and beekeeping, displaying smart land usage.

Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed visited the Shebe Sombo Woreda part of the

Kishe cluster rice production that spans three woredas in Jimma Zone.

Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed and senior government officials visited the agricultural activities that Bonga University conducts in addition to its teaching process. Both the university and the local community benefited from these efforts. According to Prime Minister Abiy, the activities demonstrate the efficient use of available resources.

Oct. 23, 2022, Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed attended the inaugural ceremony of the bakery built by the Office of the First Lady in Agaro.



Oct. 24, 2022, Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed presided over a macroeconomic committee meeting, during which he stated that Ethiopia's journey to use its internal potential to grow its economy will not be easy but requires enormous efforts and collaboration.

Oct. 27, 2022, Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed handed over a children's and youth sports facility near his office in order to encourage the creation of similar facilities where young people may exercise their bodies and acquire social skills.



Oct. 29, 2022, Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed and senior government leadership visited 8,000 farmers in the East Shewa Zone's Dugda and Bora woredas, who have grown wheat on 31,000 hectares through cluster farming. On the same day, they also paid a visit to farmers in Lume woreda, East Shewa Zone, who were finishing up harvest and planting summer irrigated wheat.



Oct. 30, 2022, Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed attended the opening of phase two of Friendship Park. He met with the children and youth who were enjoying the venue's amenities and sports activities.



On the same day, Prime Minister Abiy Ahmed met with couples who celebrated their wedding on the opening of the phase two of Friendship Park. Those who replied to the call for couples who wished to get married on the day marking the project's completion had their ceremonies at the venue. The green development which hosts national and social events is a space where individuals of all ages can unwind.
